

LOS CAYOS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING MARCH 19, 2025

A. CALL TO ORDER

The March 19, 2025, Regular Board Meeting of the Los Cayos Community Development District (the "District") was called to order at 10:13 a.m. in the offices of Lennar Homes, LLC located at 5505 Blue Lagoon Drive, Miami, Florida 33126.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Proof of publication was presented which showed that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in *Miami Herald* on September 30, 2024, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mrs. Perez determined that the presence of the following Board Members constituted a quorum and all was in order to proceed with the meeting: Chairperson Teresa Baluja, Vice Chairperson Vanessa Perez and Supervisor Raisa Krause.

Also in attendance were District Manager Gloria Perez of Special District Services, Inc., and District Counsel Michael Pawelczyk of Billing Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A.

D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. October 16, 2024, Regular Board Meeting

A **MOTION** was made by Supervisor Perez, seconded by Supervisor Baluja and passed unanimously approving the minutes of the October 16, 2024, Regular Meeting, as presented.

G. OLD BUSINESS

There were no Old Business items to come before the Board.

H. NEW BUSINESS

1. Stormwater Management System Legal Requirements Update Memorandum

Mr. Pawelczyk provided an overview of the memorandum.

2. Consider Resolution No. 2025-01 – Adopting a Proposed Fiscal Year 2025/2026 Annual Budget and Setting a Public Hearing for Final Adoption

Mrs. Perez presented Resolution No. 2025-01, entitled:

RESOLUTION 2025-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE LOS CAYOS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026 AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON PURSUANT TO FLORIDA LAW AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Debt Service Assessment is the same (maximum) as last year. The Administrative Budget is higher than last year. Numerous Maintenance line items have been added, as per the engineer's confirmation and recommendation.

The estimated available funds projected for 9-30-25 are approximately \$30,000, should no unforeseen expenses occur. This is in addition to the Import Fill Funds balance of \$644,236. No carryover balance has been issued to the Budget Options (\$0 was set-up last year).

Two Proposal Options have been presented: Option 1 is inclusive of Maintenance Costs and Option 2 has a Lower Maintenance Cost.

Due to the infrastructure that is and/or will be the District's to own in addition to the environmental requirements and engineering inspections pursuant to the covenant that was not originally anticipated at the time the cap was created, making it impossible to lower the budget any further.

Option 2 has removed the line items as requested that would need to be maintained and funded under a maintenance service agreement between the District and the Association.

If the Board chooses to proceed with Option 2, District Counsel can prepare a maintenance agreement for Board consideration, thereby passing the maintenance responsibilities on the following new line items to the Association, consisting of:

Entry Road Maintenance

Water Feature Maintenance - Weekly 4 Pools Cleaned, Backwash, Water Test, etc.

Landscape Maintenance - Bi-Weekly mow, tree & palm trimming, mulch, fertilization, pesticides, etc.

Irrigation - Monthly wet tests and regular maintenance.

Monuments Maintenance – Maintenance & pressure cleaning.

Street Lighting - Monthly Maintenance of six (6) Poles Including Electricity Cost

Sidewalks - Maintenance & Pressure Cleaning

Power Utility - Water Features, Monuments & Irrigation

Water & Sewage/Potable Water Usage – for Irrigation and Water Features

Fence Maintenance

A discussion ensued. The Board indicated that they would select Option 1 thereby leaving all of the District infrastructure under the maintenance responsibility of the District and would provide a Developer contribution from the Fill Funds balance to keep the budget within the current assessment

balance and for no increase to be issued for the fiscal year 2025/2026 budget. Notices to landowners would not be required.

A **MOTION** was made by Supervisor Krause, seconded by Supervisor Baluja unanimously passed adopting Resolution No. 2025-01, as presented, approving Proposed Budget Option 1 for FY 2025/2026 and setting the Public Hearing for <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>May 21, 2025 at 9:45 a.m.</u>, in the offices of Lennar Homes, LLC located at 5505 Waterford District Drive, Miami, Florida 33126 and further authorizing the publication of the notice, as required by law.

3. Consider Resolution No. 2025-02 – Registered Agent Change

Resolution No. 2025-02 was presented, entitled:


